

## The SeaZone Rules and Prohibitions

A warning will be given if any rule/prohibition is being violated, if it continues, a termination of the rental agreement will be made immediately with no refund given. Renter/operators/participants shall not violate any of followings during their operation of the watercraft:

- When turning ON the engine, the water level in the REAR part of watercraft must be AT LEAST 3FT DEEP. (around the thigh). NEVER turn on the engine with less than 2 ft deep. Warning will be given before any termination.
- ALWAYS have the watercraft key ATTACHED to the LIFE VEST of the OPERATOR. This will automatically turn off the engine in case the operator fall off from the watercraft. Warning will be given before any termination
- If the operator plans to leave the watercraft in NEUTRAL for more than 5 minutes, please TURN OFF the engine to avoid any overheating in the IBR system, an alarm will sound if happens, let it cool down for couple minutes before TURNING ON again. Warning will be given before any termination.
- LEAVING the designated rental area (boundaries). Warning will be given before any termination.
- There are no additional operators/participants or excess weight permitted on the watercraft unless expressly permitted by The SeaZone in the agreement prior to use. Warning will be given before any termination.
- NEVER OPERATE the watercraft after OR while consuming alcoholic beverages or taking drugs. the rental agreement will be terminated immediately, no warnings.
- ALWAYS get on board from the REAR part of the watercraft to avoid any flip over. **If FLIP OVER happens do the following steps as quick as possible:**
  - 1- Make sure the engine is OFF.
  - 2- GRAB INLET GRATE AND STEP ON BUMPER RAIL as shown in the picture.
  - 3- ROLL the watercraft COUNTERCLOCKWISE.

If the watercraft stays more than 5 minutes UPSIDE DOWN, call us as soon as possible, water could have gotten inside the engine. the rental agreement will be terminated immediately, no warnings.



### • FOR TOWABLE EQUIPMENT board / tube:

- ALWAYS use the SeaDoo GTI SE, NOT the SPARK for towing purposes. Warning will be given before any termination
- AVOID TO RUN OVER TOWABLE ROPE, the watercraft may suck the rope and the impeller will be unable to function. If happens, call as soon as possible, the rental agreement will be terminated immediately, no warnings.
- ALWAYS WAIT UNTIL THE ROPE IS FULLY TAUT before applying any throttle. It could generate too much tension for the watercraft, board or tube and parts can be broken. Warning will be given before any termination.
